

“Fear Factor” (No, Not the TV Game Show!) Transfiguration Sunday

The Transfiguration story in Matthew 17:1–9 gives us one of Scripture’s most breathtaking moments: Jesus shining like the sun, Moses and Elijah appearing in glory, and the very voice of God thundering from a cloud. But the detail we often skip past is the disciples’ reaction. They fall on their faces, terrified.

That fear is not a failure of faith. It is the natural human response to encountering the living God.

This Sunday, we explore what one pastor calls the church’s identity as a “fellowship of fear.” Not fear as entertainment, not fear as a stunt or a challenge, but the holy awe that comes when God refuses to stay safely inside our expectations. When God speaks, commands, redirects, and reveals—people tremble. And yet, in the same breath, Jesus reaches out, touches the disciples, and says, “Rise, and have no fear.”

At Edisto Island UMC, this is our rhythm, too. We gather to listen for God’s voice, even when it unsettles us. We acknowledge the fear that comes with real transformation. And we trust the grace that steadies us when the holy feels overwhelming.

This week’s sermon, “Fear Factor,” invites us to see fear not as something to avoid, but as something God can use to shape us. The Transfiguration prepares the disciples for the journey down the mountain—toward service, sacrifice, and the cross. In the same way, worship prepares us for the week ahead, forming us into people who can follow Jesus with courage.

Come ready to listen.

Come ready to tremble a little.

Come ready to rise at Christ’s touch.

Worship begins at 10:00 AM. All are welcome.


